Who Governs United Way of Greater Houston?

United Way of Greater Houston is governed by an unpaid Board of Trustees made up of local volunteers from across the community. These volunteers determine policy and oversee every aspect of the organization. Professional staff manages day-to-day activities.

Does United Way of Greater Houston Provide 100% of an Agency's Funding?

No. United Way provides only a portion of their funding. Agencies typically have additional sources of income such as government and foundation grants, client fees (generally based on the client's income) and funds generated through fundraising activities. The portion of an agency's budget that comes from United Way is critical for many reasons. It allows the agency to draw on matching funds from other sources and to leverage resources in other ways.

Is My Gift to United Way Tax Deductible?
