\$50 per week (\$2,600 Total Gift)	A night out for two at your favorite sporting venue.	Provides resources and support to 21 individuals recently diagnosed with cancer. DID YOU KNOW? Over 1 million individuals in Harris County do not have health insurance.
\$100 per week (\$5,200 Total Gift)	A date night.	Provides 20 children with quality supervised afterschool activities. DID YOU KNOW? 1 in 4 children is left alone after school.
\$200 per week (\$10,400 Total Gift)	A round of golf for four.	Provides employment services for 325 individuals . DID YOU KNOW? In the past year, unemployment topped 8.4% in Harris County.
